

Dear Bulldog Families,

The recent tragedy at Stoneman Douglas weighs heavy on our hearts as we move into March. We have spoken to several families seeking reassurances that our campus is safe. Being a new facility is to our advantage as we have perimeter fencing, key card access to buildings, and security cameras. We also have polices and procedures in place to support safety. If we all commit to supporting those polices, we can be proactive and ensure that Every Bulldog, Every Day feels safe coming to school. Some reminders:

1. All visitors must sign in and be scanned through our raptor system. Even those who are known to us, frequent visitors, and volunteers. This is the Superintendent's expectation.
2. Families may drop their children off at the front gate each morning. Please wait to the side so that we can easily open the gate. In the afternoon, parents of Hiker/Biker students who want to wait for them must do so off campus behind the sign designating the pick-up area.
3. If you are joining your child for lunch, we will radio the cafeteria or call the classroom to have your child join you. This is a change as we have previously asked parents to wait outside until the line passed. Only your child will be allowed to join you.

We understand that some of these procedures are different from previous schools or inconvenient and appreciate your cooperation! In addition to the above measures, we continue to have our crisis plans in place. In the first semester, we practiced barricading ourselves by "building a fort" and in the next few weeks we will be partnering with law enforcement to practice evacuation. These events are planned with care and thoughtfulness and in consideration of the age of our students.
