Last year, we had 572 students on opening day and this year, we have 813! All teams and teachers will be communicating with families using Class Dojo. Schoolwide messages will be sent via the Remind App, which you can download to your phone. School Messenger will still be used as well, so please keep your contact information up to date, as the calls are sent from the My Student demographics.

If you have not already done so, please complete the online application necessary to become an approved volunteer. Even if you have no plans to assist in the classrooms, only approved volunteers are allowed to be on campus, attend field trips, or participate in classroom events. If you need support completing the information online, please contact the school.

As in the past, on time attendance is the key to your child's success. School begins promptly at 9:40 and dismissal begins with car riders at 3:40. For your child's safety, please do not drop them off prior to 9:20. We will not dismiss students from the class after 3:15 to ensure safe afternoon dismissal.

Assisting with our campus safety this year is Robert Olding, our School Safety Guard. You will see him at arrival and dismissal and the students will see him frequently around campus. We are happy to have him join our Bulldog team!


